DAY 1

We meet at Grand Central Airport for a true South African style brunch and we board our private aircraft for a short flight over Hartebeespoort. After arrival at Pilanesberg Airport at 10am, we have a short transfer to Pilanesberg Nature reserve for a game drive. We check in back at the Pilanesberg airport at 2pm and clear customs for a flight to Swakopmund and check in at Strand.

DAY 2

After breakfast on the deck overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, we get ready for a game unique game drive in the Namib-Naukluft nature reserve. We also make a visit to Woermannhaus and Swakopmund Museum after a traditional Namibian fish & chips lunch. An early evening quad bike safari in the reserve is followed by a traditional Namibian dinner back at the Strand Hotel.

DAY 3

We check out at the Strand and have a short game drive and transfer to the private airport. A very scenic flight over the dunes and contrast of the desert and ocean takes us to a private nature reserve in Etosha. We check in at The Fort after a game drive transfer. The Fort is famous for its breathtakingly unique sunsets and stone clad rustic design.

DAY 4

We enjoy an early continental breakfast followed by a three hour game drive in the Onguma nature reserve. The reserve spans 34 000ha and incorporates ecological substrata such as savannah, bushveld, omuramba and dry pan. A brunch is served and we enjoy an afternoon at leisure back at the camp. The evening sunset cruise on the Etosha is followed by a bush dinner.

DAY 5

We enjoy a guided morning walking safari in the Onguma reserve and enjoy a final Namibian breakfast overlooking the plains of the Namib. A short game drive and transfer takes us to our private plane and we enjoy a scenic flight back to Johannesburg.
